Payment Information:

Rainbow Homes is now accepting payments for trips using several methods:

- Checks (Payable to Rainbow Homes)
- Credit cards
- Cash

Please come into the Rainbow Homes office to use credit/debit. We can accept Mastercard, Visa, American Express or Discover card. If a credit/debit card is used, there is 3% surcharge added to the cost of the trip via Square or Stripe.
